6. Specific Event	When I tried to milk the cow, the milk spilled on the ground.	What happened when he tried to milk the cow?
7. Ground (or explanation) of event	The flowers wilted because he hadn't put them in water.	Why did the flowers wilt?
8. Purpose	I went to the barn to milk the cow.	Why did he go to the barn?
9. Result	An insect bit the cow and she kicked over the bucket of milk.	What happened when an insect bit the cow?
10.Cause	An insect bit the cow and she kicked over the bucket of milk.	What caused the cow to kick over the bucket of milk?
11.Time	One morning, as I was milking the cow, the milk spilled on the ground.	When was he milking the cow?
